Topic(s): False Teachers

Bottomline of the Message: False teachers are wrong and destructive to Christian living

NextStep: 1. Know the truth 2. See the fruit

Discussion Questions:

1. Play the game 2 truths and a lie.

- 2. Read 2 Peter 2:1. Peter tells of three characteristics of a false teacher: Secretive, destructive, and denying Jesus as Lord.
 - a. Who do you see showing these characteristics today? (i.e., Cults, Prosperity Gospel, other non-Christian religions, etc.)
- 3. Read 2 Peter 2:2-3 or 2 Timothy 4:3.
 - a. Why do people follow false teachers?
- 4. Read 2 Peter 2: 4-10 "Peter uses all the stories to say IF God passed judgement as well as saved the righteous, THEN God will do the same today!"
 - a. How does God rescue the godly?
- 5. Bottom Line: False teachers are wrong and destructive to Christian living. Read Matthew 7:15.
 - a. Jesus calls false teachers "ravenous wolves." Does this impact how you view false teachers? How/why?
- 6. Read John 8:31-32. The 1st NextStep was know the TRUTH
 - a. What does it mean to "abide" in God's word?
- 7. Read John 7:15-20 The 2nd NextStep was See the Fruit
 - a. How can you see the "fruit" of a person?
